The February Roundtable will be held on Thursday, February 11th starting at 7:30 pm.

After the announcements period, both of the Cub Scout and Boy Scout break out groups will meet together to discuss the Bear/Webelos Program, Webelos to Scout Transition, what each of the 2 groups are looking for when Webelos are looking for a Troop, and then there will be an open discussing about how Packs and Troops can support each other over the course of the Scout year.

On the Cub Scout side, all Bears, Webelos 1, and Webelos 2 leaders should attend. We will be discussing how the Cub Scout program is designed to prepare the boys for Boy Scouts, and there will be a couple of parents of first year Boy Scouts there to discuss how well the Webelos program prepared them for Boy Scouts.

Troop Leaders will be available for current Webelos 2 Leaders to set up times to visit their Troops, and **Webelos 1 Leaders** can make contact with Troops to establish joint activities over the summer or next year when they are Webelos 2s. **Bear leaders** will be able to get a preview about the Webelos Program and see the steps they will need to be taking over the next couple of years.

We will also **be discussing the Cub Scout Camping and Outdoor Program and BALOO**

training.

Pack Leaders: please bring your Bear, Webelos, **and any outdoor oriented parent** with you to the meeting.

Troop Leaders: bring your ASMs involved with developing Pack contacts, and your 1st year Scout programs; and, feel free to bring along a couple of first year Scouts or parents who can discuss the transition from Webelos to the first year of Boy Scouts.
